The Stakes Are High

- Think beyond typical emergency management structures
- Situations are can be dire and a myriad of multidimensional and complex challenges
- They're not exactly the same and no one-size fits all approach can be used
- Requires considerable collaboration, communication, coordination, cooperation, and consideration to establish convention

The Stakes Are High

- The issues are political, and not just with those elected officials
- Fundamentally the issues are at a number of levels with competing interests of those involved
- Enable consideration at all levels of all partners and stakeholders
- Ensuring harmony and cohesion is crucial in ensuring effective and efficient response and recovery







The Stakes Are High

- Don't let poor technology or data collection systems, inadequate reporting, lack of public awareness and inclusiveness lead to poor information being disseminated to stakeholders, this can lead to being unprepared and therefore lead to inaction.
- Build transparent and collaborative structures
- Develop efficient and effective information dissemination
- Inclusive evidence-based decision making
